

Rules for the 2022-2023 Indoor Soccer League

Facility

- 1. All players must complete the kiosk waivers upon arrival in the lobby.
- 2. Players/teams should not come into the team area/playing area prior to the previous game/training session concluding.
- 3. NO FOOD, GUM, OR DRINK ON THE FIELDS. This includes halftime.
- 4. The St. Luke's Sports Rink/Fieldhouse allows for cleats, indoor cleats, or sneakers. **No metal** cleats.

Team Rules

- 5. All players must be 18 + years of age.
- 6. No numbers are required on jerseys.
- 7. Teams must wear matching colors. If both teams are wearing the same color, one team will wear pinnies.
- 8. Coed: There must be 1 female on the field at all times.
- 9. Roster size: Roster sizes are between 8-15 players.

Game Play

- 10. The referee will control the clock. Halves are 22 minutes long with a 3-minute halftime.
- 11. Players are not required to wear shin guards.
- 12. The games are full-field with 8 players (7 field players and a goalkeeper).
- 13. Coaches can choose to play with less than the number of players listed above but can not require the opponent to do the same.
- 14. Offsides will not be called.
- 15. No slide tackling.
- 16. The ball is considered out of bounds when it makes contact with any part of the facility not in play: netting, ceiling, sideline, and end line.
- 17. Throw-ins are to be taken on the sidelines. No kick-ins.
- 18. Defenders must be at least 10 feet from the ball on free kicks or restarts.
- 19. The outdoor pass-back rule to a keeper is in effect. The keeper must have one foot in the penalty area to touch the ball with their hands.
- **20.** After gaining control of the ball, the keeper must distribute the ball with a throw (no punting or drop-kicks).
- 21. Goal kick must touch a player or the floor before entering the goal.
- 22. Sub on the fly. Players should be off the field before sub enters. Keeper may hold the ball longer than 5 seconds to allow subs at referee's discretion.
- 23. FIFA rules apply unless specified otherwise. Calls and penalties are at the referee's discretion.
- 24. Penalty kicks are taken at the designated spot on the field.
- 25. If a player receives a yellow card, that player can continue playing. If a player receives a second yellow card, that player will be sent off for the remainder of the game and the team will play short one player for the remainder of the game. If a goalkeeper receives two yellow cards the team will play short one player but you may put in another goalkeeper.

- 26. If a player receives a direct red card, that player will be out for the remainder of the game and the team will play short one player for the remainder of the game. If a goalkeeper receives a red card the team will play short one player but you may put in another goalkeeper. A player who receives a red card is given a 1-match ban.
- 27. NO PROTESTS ALLOWED. The referee is responsible for all game decisions.

Cancellations and Reschedules

- 28. If a game is canceled due to weather conditions, captains will be emailed.
- 29. Weather-related cancellation reschedules will be made up at the end of the season unless otherwise notified.

Standings

- 30. Win =3 points, Tie = 1 point, Loss = 0 points
- 31. Tiebreaker Criteria if Needed
 - a. Head-to-Head Competition (2-Team tie only)
 - b. Total Goal Differential Maximum (Maximum 6 goal differential per game)
 - c. Least Total Goals Allowed
 - d. Least Red Cards Received/Least Yellow Cards Received

Communication

- 32. There will be a St. Luke's Sports Fieldhouse site manager present who can speak about facility-related issues, concerns, and/or injuries.
- 33. The Winter League Director has the final say over all league matters.
